# Re-opening of school to Year 6 pupils next Wednesday 10 June 2020

We have been working hard to put in place necessary measures to limit the risk of coronavirus transmitting within our school. There is important guidance for you, if you have chosen to bring your child to school. The guidance is issued with this letter along with a revised home school agreement and behaviour policy. Please read all this information carefully and discuss it with your child. There is a lot of information to read but this letter gives you important headlines.

Please see the details below of the bubble your child will be in. Two members of staff have been allocated to each bubble (a teacher and a TA) and will not mix across other bubble groups.

Times are staggered for different bubble groups in order to minimise contact with other groups of pupils and parents. Please ensure you are on time when dropping off or collecting your child in order to maintain social distancing. Year 6 pupils who have permission to walk home by themselves will continue to do so unless you inform us otherwise.

#### **Attendance**

Your child has been allocated to a bubble group regardless of your survey response. The government strongly encourages parents with children in eligible year groups to bring their children in every day. However, this is your choice and there will be no penalties for non-attendance. If your child is going to be absent, please report your child's absence using the absence line.

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# **Lunch arrangements**

All pupils will need to be provided with a packed lunch next Wednesday to Friday.

From the week beginning Monday 15 June, **hot lunches will be provided by our catering provider**, The Pantry. Menus will be available on our website. Meals need to be ordered in advance so we will contact you regarding this next week. This will be for four days only, Mondays to Thursdays. On Fridays, the school will be closing early for teachers to plan, oversee home-learning and for our cleaners to give the school a thorough clean. Therefore, on Fridays, a take-away packed lunch will be the option. ParentPay will continue to be used for payments.

If you are eligible for free school meals and your child is attending school, you will no longer receive any more vouchers from 15 June.

### School uniform

It is recommended that children's uniform is washed at the end of every day and as realise this may be difficult, we have decided that pupils can come in their own clothes (non-uniform) and wear trainers, as there will be daily exercise.

# Water bottles and equipment

Please provide your child with a water bottle each day. Please ensure it is labelled with your child's name.

If your child brought their school pencil case home when the school closed in March, please ask them to bring it back when they return.

### **Updated pupil information**

Please ensure that the information we hold for your child is accurate. Email or phone the office directly if there are any changes to the information we currently hold including: contact details (including emergency contact details); medical, allergy or dietary information so we can update our records and inform the staff in the bubble.

I thank you in advance for following the guidance and look forward to seeing your child next Wednesday 10 June.
