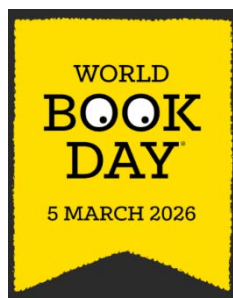
Please join us in the hall to meet Natasha Campbell, Enfield's Education Welfare Officer. Natasha can provide you with advice and information on the importance of school attendance.

We have been informed of an outbreak of measles in a school in Enfield which has resulted in a small number of children requiring hospitalisation. This means that if your child (or you as an adult) are not fully vaccinated against measles with 2 doses of the measles, mumps and rubella (MMR) vaccine, you are at risk of developing measles (unless you have had measles in the past).
