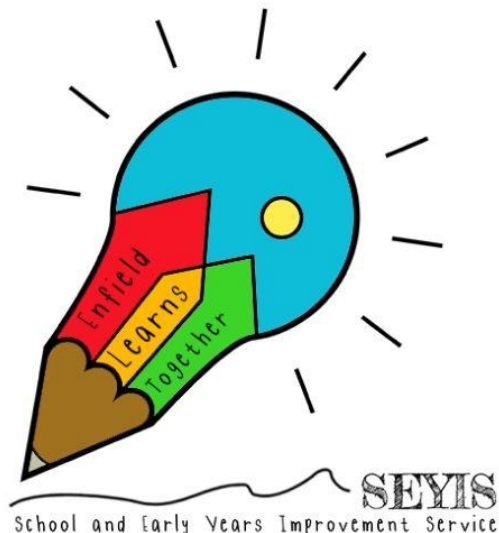


# Art Challenge
