English

We will be looking closely at the adventures of Fred and his mismatched group of friends whose plane crashes into the Amazon Rainforest from the book titled 'The Explorers'. This book fits perfectly with our topic and also covers issues from friendship to protecting the environment.

The national curriculum objectives covered in this unit are:

- Using the correct tense consistently
- Writing in the first person
- Punctuating sentences correctly
- Using fronted adverbials to begin sentences

The genres/text types we will cover are:

- Autobiographies
- Narratives
- Setting descriptions

Maths

Our main focus will be number. This will include:

- Understanding the place value of digits in 4-digit numbers
- Ordering and comparing numbers beyond 1000
- Using the formal written method for addition and subtraction
- Solving problems which require an understanding of addition and subtraction
- Learning multiplication and division facts up to 12x12
- Using formal methods for multiplication and division

We will also be studying 2D shapes:

- Comparing and classifying triangles and rectangles
- Understanding symmetry

Science, Technology & ICT

- Science: 'Living things and their habitats'. Pupils will learn how to use classification keys to sort different animals and how humans are impacting different habitats.
- ICT: We will incorporate the use of ICT throughout our learning this half term by teaching pupils how to record, research and plan using a range of apps and devices.

Humanities (History, Geography & RE)

- Geography: Pupils will study the Amazon Rainforest and make comparisons between the UK and South America. Pupils will look at the impact humans are having on the environment and ways in which this can be stopped. They will learn the key differences between physical and human geography.
- History: During October, we will celebrate Black History Month.

PSHE

Our focus will be 'All about us'. During this unit, the pupils will:

- Learn the value of co-operation through discussing conflict management
- Learn the value of responsibility through studying and researching human impact on the environment

PE

Home Learning

Please support your child with their home learning by asking what they have been learning and reading through work sent home with them. They may need your help with some tasks. If your child is having problems, please speak to the class teacher as soon as possible so that we can work together to support your child's learning.

Home Learning is set on a Thursday and collected in on a Tuesday.

Reading: 20 minutes daily.

Writing: Written task based around a word or phrase relevant to something that they are, or will be, covering in school.

Spelling: Weekly spellings handed out and to be practised daily.

Maths: Online MyMaths, related to work completed during school. Daily times tables practice.
